## **PENGUIN TOUR – WINTER GOLF – SENIOR, SUPER SENIOR, SUPER SUPER SENIOR DIVISIONS**

All events will be held at Briarwood. **Golf Cart Services / EZ-GO** will supply “**Players of the Week**” and **Foot-Joy** will supply “**Player of the Year**” awards. ### **GOLF TIPS FOR SENIORS**

- Keep practicing. There's no other way around it, nor is there a magic spell that will have you automatically become a better golfer! Even once a week is great, so long as you keep it up.
- Maintain a healthy diet and exercise in order to keep the energy for your swings and long walks around the golf course. You'll feel better and have a quality game. Maintain your strength as much as possible through consuming food high in calcium and exercising every day.
- Practice your position and swing, even while you aren't golfing. Distribute your weight evenly when in position, and practice swings with your usual golf club to get used to its weight.
- Warm up before a game to keep your stamina and flexibility levels up. Plus, you'll prevent injury that way. Stretch for around 5 minutes before a game.
- Invest on good golfing equipment suitable for you in order to prevent injury and ensure comfort. This calls for comfortable shoes and good golf clubs.
