EARLY SIGN-UP

Please find your enclosed BRIARWOOD AARP registration card. The registration fee for this season is \$33.00. Remember, **ALL GOLFERS AGE 50 AND UP** MAY BECOME BRIARWOOD AARP MEMBERS. You may sign up early and pay your dues at the clubhouse. **Tee times can be confirmed and season schedules will be available beginning Monday, March 18th**. You may also mail your check for **\$33.00** along with your registration card. The fee covers the cost of mailings, handicaps and special awards, plus all the benefits we get from AARP GOLF.

AARP RATES

Rates for the **2024 AARP** season are:

9-holes walking - \$14.75, 9-holes riding - \$20.00,
18-holes walking - \$20.50, 18-holes riding - \$31.00.

All players pay an additional \$1.00 for prizes.

PLAY GOLF AT THE REDUCED AARP RATE – MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY

Play Monday through Friday before 1:00 pm and pay the reduced AARP rates. This is strictly for fun. A tournament will not be run and prize money will not be collected. Just show your **Briarwood AARP Membership Card** and enjoy the benefits of being a member of our group. Remember if you want to play in the weekly AARP tournaments, you need to be here Wednesdays for the 8:30 am shotgun and/or Thursdays no later than 9:00 am & Fridays no later than 8:30 am. *Offer not valid on holidays, with outings, leagues or any other offer.*

OFFICAL PLAYING DATES

The Wednesday 18-hole Group will start March 27th. The first official playing date for the 9-hole Thursday group will be Thursday, March 28th. The 9-hole Friday group will officially begin on Friday, April 5th (**there will be no AARP golf on Good Friday, March 29th**). Scores will be recorded from the opening dates when we will be hitting from the regular tees.

STARTERS/RANGERS

Starters will help things run smoothly by starting groups at their tee times. Please be on the tee 10 minutes in advance of your tee time. The starter will allow you to move up only if the tee is open. Rangers will be on the course to check the pace of play. **Play ready golf to make it a pleasant experience for everyone! Please try to stay one shot behind the group ahead of you.**

This group has been running smoothly, averaging just a little over four hours. Please indicate on the sign-up sheet if you ride or walk, as whenever possible, walkers will be assigned nearby holes and riders more distant holes. The first date of official play will be Wednesday, March 27th.
