**ONLINE PAYMENT/TELEPHONE PAYMENT OF GREEN FEE, CART & PRIZE MONEY**

If you would like to pay without entering the clubhouse, we have two options (*online or by telephone*). If using one of our pre-pay options, please pre-pay the day before or day of play to help us with bookkeeping. Go to "shop" on the upper right corner of the website and click on the "League/Aarp/Ladies Green Fees" option, you will find a button to purchase a green fee for the Aarp league (Wednesday 18-holes or Thursday/Friday 9-holes). If riding, a cart can be paid for under the "League/Aarp/Lady Cart" tab. To pay prize money, go to the "Aarp & Ladies Prize \$" tab. You will have to create a login and password to make the purchase. We will receive an email letting us know payment was made. When arriving, report to the cart staff outside to acquire your cart. You may call 717-792-9776 to pay by credit card.

**18 HOLE TOURNAMENTS ON WEDNESDAYS**

Nice weather has arrived and this group will fill up fast! Please sign up for each week of play. If you decide not to play after you sign up, **please call the clubhouse to cancel**. There is a player limit. Play ready golf to maintain a steady pace of play. This makes it pleasurable for all. Walkers are assigned to nearby holes. So, please indicate on the sign-up sheet if you ride or walk.

**SENIOR 2-MAN SCRAMBLE TOURNAMENT – MONDAY, JUNE 24<sup>th</sup>**

Golfers 50 & up are welcome to play Briarwood's Senior 2-Man Scramble Tournament. This 9:00 am shotgun, 18-hole event will be played with all participants playing from the Gold tee markers.
